

2010 Prairie Art Exhibit and Auction

Call for Entry

In previous years, Prairie Art Exhibit and Auction has been invitational. However, due to its overwhelming success and inquiries from a great number of professional artists, Symphony in the Flint Hills has decided to invite all artists to submit work to be juried for exhibition. Artists are eligible to submit two (2) paintings each, but not required. Juror/s to be announced later.

Artwork Requirements:

Painting must be thematically or graphically reference the Flint Hills of Kansas. The two-dimensional artwork must not exceed 36 inches in either dimension. Artwork must be framed or gallery-wrapped canvas with fully painted edges and strap hangers with screws must be used to secure the wire hangers, no sawtooths, please.

A high definition digital of the artwork must be submitted by **February 12, 2010** with title, dimension, and type of medium. Artist will be contacted by **March 1st** if their artwork is accepted with additional instructions.

Pricing

All artwork selected for the event will be eligible for auction. Artists are requested to set a retail reserve price; this will be the starting price for the auction. The artist will receive half (50%) of the total auctioned price, if sold, the remaining half (50%) is to be considered as a donation to the Symphony in the Flint Hills.

If your artwork does not sell, you must take the artwork home with you after the event.

Right to Reproduce Image for Purpose of Promotion, Resale and Publicity

Symphony in the Flint Hills, Inc. reserves the right to reproduce images for the purpose of publicity and promotion in the form of greeting cards, informational handouts, etc. One piece of artwork will be selected as the official Symphony in the Flint Hills 2010 Commemorative Print. By submitting artwork to this exhibition, each artist agrees to this statement. Each artist retains the rights to print reproductions of their own work at their cost and to the proceeds from these prints.

Symphony in the Flint Hills Concert Tickets

Each artist with selected entry/s is offered one free admission to Symphony in the Flint Hills, with the option to purchase one additional ticket at full value. If you accept this offer, you will be required to work for hour in the Prairie Art tent hosting the displayed artwork. Schedule to be determined.

Liability and Responsibilities

Artists retain liability for accepted artwork. Symphony in the Flint Hills assumes no liability for the artwork submitted whether in transit or during its housing. By submitting artwork to this event, each artist agrees to this statement.
